	<p>In his thirty-year career at Health Canada, Douglas Haines has been engaged in environmental health issues spanning air pollution, ecosystem health, climate change, and chemical monitoring. Under the Government of Canada's Chemicals Management Plan, he developed and implemented national human biomonitoring initiatives to track Canadians' exposures to chemicals and their integration into health risk assessments. This includes the Canadian Health Measures Survey, the Maternal-Infant Research on Environmental Chemicals and partnership in the Northern Contaminants Program. Mr. Haines has managed the health components of the Great Lakes and St. Lawrence ecosystem programs. He has published in peer reviewed journals and has presented at Canadian and international, scientific, public and policy venues. He is the Chair of the HBM4EU Advisory Board.</p>
